eLibrary Proposal Guidelines

This form is intended to give the Publications Committee a clear idea of the project in a concise manner. Please provide as much as possible of the material and information requested. On submission, your proposal will be read by the appropriate administrator and forwarded to the Publications Committee for approval. It is our goal to make publication decisions as quickly and efficiently as possible. However, the review process does take time, so if there are any timing issues specific to your project that we should bear in mind (e.g. the proposal is under consideration by another publisher), please let us know.

- 1) Event Information:** Provide the official title of the journal/conference along with a proposed acronym and the contact information of the current Editor-in-Chief/Program Chair.
- 2) Brief Description:** In 250 words or less, provide a brief description of the collections purpose. Include the collection grouping: AIS Journals, AIS Conferences, AIS Chapters, AIS Special Interest Groups, AIS Affiliated Conferences, Other Conferences (see <http://aisel.aisnet.org/communities.html> for more information).
- 3) Description of Content:** In one page, provide a list of years to include in the AIS eLibrary along with the number of submission per year (e.g. SAIS2008: 55 papers, sais2009: 58 papers, etc.)
- 4) For Journals only:** In one to two pages, please provide a full description of the journal for the “About this Journal” page, a list of past Editors-in-Chief, general information on the policies for the journal, and format requirements for submitting to your journal.
- 5) Collection Administrator/Editors:** Provide the names and email addresses of those charged with uploading content to the AIS eLibrary.
- 7) Peer Review:** Briefly describe the peer review process (e.g. single-blind, double-blind)
- 6) Timing issues:** Are there any timing restraints to consider?
